In the McDonough County Circuit Court in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and Seventy-Seven

Now on this 6th day of September, A. D. 19 77, comes into court in his own person, William D. Henderson, State's Attorney in and for said county, in the name and by authority of the People of the State of Illinois, and prosecutes in this behalf for and on behalf of said People and informs said court that

GEORGE G. TOLBERT

on or about the 14th day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and Seventy-Seven, at and within the said County of McDonough in the State of

Illinois, aforesaid, a person of the age of 17 years and upwards, performed an act of deviate sexual conduct upon Mark B. Wolff, a child under the age of 16 years, in that he placed his mouth upon the sex organ of said Mark B. Wolff, and did then and there, thereby, commit the offense of **INDECENT LIBERTIES WITH A CHILD**, in violation of Chapter 38, Section 11-4(a) (2) of the Illinois Revised Statutes

contrary to the form of the Statute in such case made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the same People of the State of Illinois.

prosecutes in this behalf for and on behalf of said People and informs the Court that

University, Macomb, McDonough County, Illinois, with the intent to commit therein
the felony of Indecent Liberties with a Child, and did then and there, thereby,
commit the offense of BURGLARY, in violation of Chapter 38, Section 19-1(a) of
the Illinois Revised Statutes

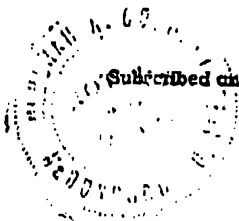

ORDER SENTENCING TO PROBATION

This cause coming on for hearing on sentencing and the People of the State of Illinois, being represented by John R. Clerkin, State's Attorney in and for McDonough County, Illinois, and the Defendant, George G. Tolbert, being present in Open Court with his attorney, E. Duke McNeil, and it appearing to the Court that the said Defendant has entered his plea of guilty to INDECENT LIBERTIES WITH A CHILD and BURGLARY; that a pre-sentence report has been filed herein which Defendant has inspected and has no objections thereto, and the Court finds;

1. That an imprisonment in the penitentiary is not necessary for the protection of the public.
2. That correctional treatment of defendant can most effectively be provided by a sentence other than imprisonment in the penitentiary.
3. That probation would neither depreciate the seriousness of defendant's conduct nor be inconsistent with the ends of justice.



IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE COURT that the Defendant, George G. Tolbert be and he is hereby sentenced to probation for a period of four (4) years upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

1. That said Defendant shall not violate any criminal statutes of any jurisdiction.
2. That the Defendant make a report to and appear in person before such person or agency as directed by the Court.
3. That said Defendant shall pay Court costs in the amount of \$ 448⁰⁰₇₂.
Court costs to be paid within six (6) months.
4. That said Defendant shall pay a fine of \$500.00, fine to be paid within six (6) months.
5. That said Defendant shall continue psychiatric treatment.
6. That said Defendant serve a sentence of forty-five (45) weekends (90 days) in the Cook County Department of Corrections to be served on consecutive weekends, commencing September 7, 1979, Friday 8:30 p.m. Said periodic imprisonment should be on weekends beginning Friday, 8:30 p.m. through and until release Sunday at 8:00 a.m.
7. Any and all costs of incarceration shall be born by the defendant and he shall reimburse McDonough County for any costs.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the said Defendant, George G. Tolbert, be and he is hereby remanded to the custody of said Probation Officer upon the conditions aforesaid and that the Probation Officer shall report any violation of the terms of this order to this Court together with his recommendations.
